Re-Entry Plan 2021-2022

This plan is based on the recommendations from Alberta Education and the Chief Medical Officer of Health.



Daily Screening & Staying at Home

Before sending your child to school each day, parents/guardians will be required to complete the Alberta Health Daily Checklist screening questions for Covid-19 symptoms. If your child is exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19, they must stay home. Self-isolation will be for 10 days.



Mask Use

When school returns on August 31, 2021 it will be optional for all students as well as staff to wear non-medical masks in the school building. However, masks are mandatory for all bus riders (Prek - Grade 12) which will be in effective until September 27, 2021.



Enhanced Cleaning

We have developed a COVID-19 cleaning standard for all schools that aligns with provincial guidelines and disinfecting. All schools will have a daytime custodian to implement ongoing general area cleaning and disinfecting high touch surfaces.



Extracurricular Activities

Schools will evaluate whether they can offer extracurricular activities that follow COVID-19 protocols and let families know which activities are available. Students will be able to participate in those activities regardless of whether they choose in-person or at-home learning.



Hygiene and Hand Washing

Everyone who enters a school will be required to use hand sanitizer or wash their hands immediately. Schools will provide hand sanitizer to support these requirements.



Lunch and Snack Time

All students must wash their hands before eating and only eat their own food. Students are not permitted to share food under the provincial health guidelines.
