- ❖ A signed Testimonial from the parents that the Main Sponsor (Godparent) has received the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Catholic Church.
- If choosing an Additional Godparent, a signed Testimonial of at least their Baptism in a Recognized Faith.
- ❖ If choosing more than 1 Godparent, 1 must be male and the other female (Canon Law 874) and over 16 years of age.
