Highlights

- We are proud of our 90.2% result in the Welcoming, Caring, Safe, Respectful Learning Environment measure. Staff continued to provide environments where students felt safe, and learning is the priority.
- We continued to focus on providing inclusive learning opportunities supporting student success which led to 93.5% satisfaction with Education Quality.
- Our diverse learning environments required that we had available supports to meet all of the needs. 92.8% of students indicated that they knew how to access supports and services to help them with their learning and social-emotional needs.
